#### A Note from the Pastor

Then the Spirit led Jesus up into the wilderness so that the devil might tempt him. After Jesus had fasted for forty days and forty nights, he was starving.

-Matthew 4: 1-2

What are you starving for? If you are like me, it isn't because we have gone without food for forty days—or even forty hours! But we all hunger for something at least some of the time. Lent is a good time to contemplate what feeds us emotionally as well as spiritually. As I mentioned in the last edition of The Outlook, we begin a new worship series in Lent from Discipleship Ministries that first helps us look inward and then asks us to reflect on what we do with our soul's yearnings to affect the world around us. Discipleship Ministries included "Coins for Lent" calendars, which you received in the last Outlook. I have since taken a closer look at each day's assignment, and I realized we may have questions. For example, Ash Wednesday's assignment is to give a coin for every lamp. Does that mean just the desk, floor and table lamps, or does it include overhead lighting? I leave that type question up to you. Counting the lamps in our home is a great way to count some of the blessings we enjoy and perhaps don't consider often, and placing a coin (any denomination) in a can or jar to give to mission is an added blessing as well as a way to praise God. You will note that the Sundays, which are not considered days of Lent, suggest prayers of gratitude. I hope those of you who decide to participate in this process will feel blessed. The money will be used in memory of Louise Clay's long dedication to mission.

Our Wednesday Bible study resumes on March 1. Led by Bill Blair, we will study a book called Everyday Contemplative: The Way of Prayerful Living by L. Roger Owens. It is available in paperback and in an electronic version. Disciple IV continues on Thursday afternoons.
