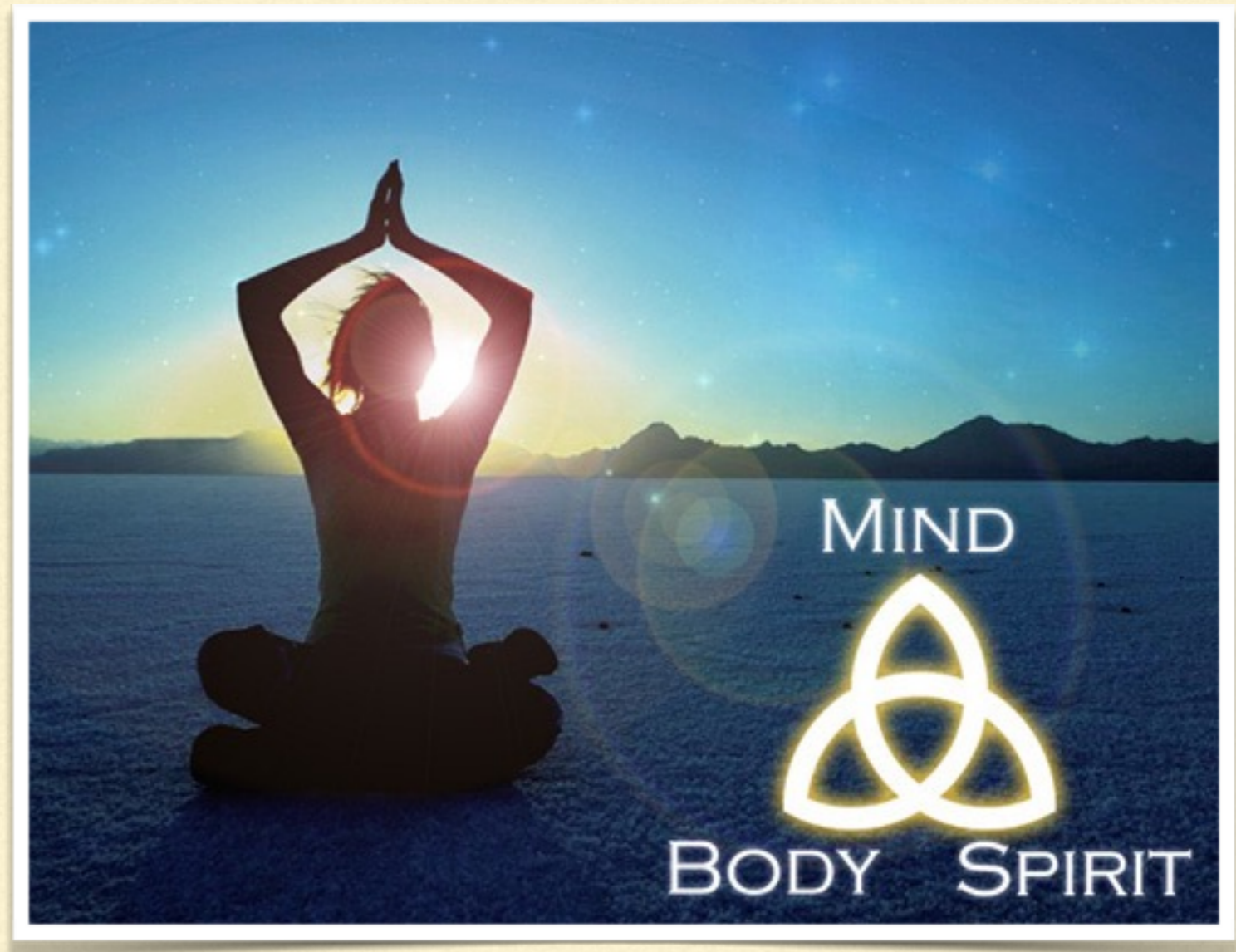




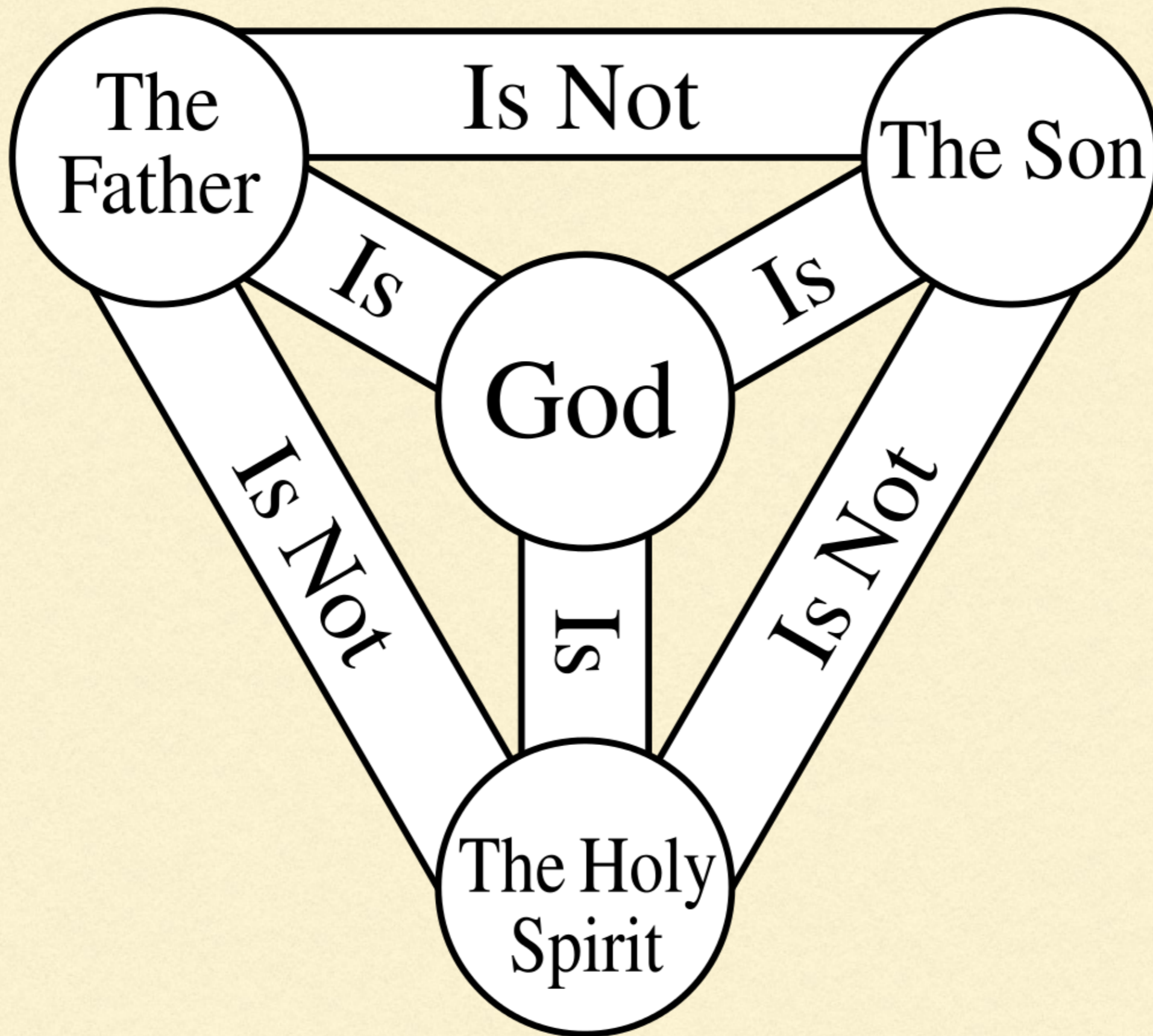
ATOM ANALOGY
